Caretaking update: RVS had to eliminate positions over the summer (funding). NPS has one HBO who goes between NPS and Coopers. One day cleaner is in one building. Night time caretaking. Not as many as previous years. Recycling is in admins hands. They do recycling pick up with students on Wed/Fri. 10 mins to clean each classroom. Bathrooms/eating areas are top priority. Students and staff are noticing. Admin and HBO have voiced their concerns to their management.

Literacy and Numeracy assessments are complete as of end of September. Allows teachers to see where students are at and cluster kids.

year.
